## January 2012 Club News & Registration Letter

### Introduction

Welcome Back! Best wishes to all our member families for the New Year. Planning for the 2012 outdoor soccer season is well underway! We encourage you to read this newsletter carefully as there is a lot of valuable information in it.

**NEW** - The registration fees for club players has increased by approximately 10% this year. This increase is to cover the player cost, as well as recovering costs from past years.

The Ontario Soccer Association is implementing programing for Long Term Player Development, which encompasses the following:

- Training Coaches as per the new format
- Shifting the focus from winning to player development. Therefore the U9 – U10 competitive programs will NOT have standings or statistics recorded.

### Club Programs

**Just Kick It! – 4 to 7 year olds.** Children will receive instruction in the fundamentals of soccer, have practice drills, and put their new skills to use in a fun scrimmage. Just Kick It! is held on Friday nights at Beckwith Park. The season runs from mid-June to the last week of August.

Experienced U7 players have the opportunity to choose one final year in Just Kick It! or to play on a mixed U7/U8 GLSL team.

### **Recreational Youth – 8 to 18 year olds**

Recreational players are placed on teams that play in the Goulbourn Lanark Soccer League (GLSL). This program offers new and experienced youth players a single level of recreational play. Carleton Place Soccer Club teams practice once a week and have a game once a week against teams from Carleton Place, Almonte, Smiths Falls, and Perth in alternating locations.

### **Competitive Youth – 8 to 18 year olds**

Competitive players are selected for teams that play in the Eastern Ontario District Soccer Association (EODSA) or Eastern Regional Soccer League (ERSL). CPSC teams practice at least twice a week and have a game once a week. Teams will be hosted at all age levels where feasible. Game locations will be determined by other teams entered in each age division.

### **Adult Soccer – 19 year olds and up**

Adults have a great selection of teams and different playing levels to choose from. Check out the Game Nights chart for the different teams the Carleton Place Soccer Club enters in the Goulbourn Lanark Soccer League (GLSL) and the Ottawa-Carleton Soccer League (OCSL).

### Equipment

Just Kick It! players will receive a team jersey, theirs to keep, which is generously donated by our local **Tim Horton's** in Carleton Place.

This year the Club will be providing Diadora kits (shirt, short & socks) for Youth and Adult players. This uniform as a whole needs to worn for every game.

All Players must supply their own shin pads, which are mandatory, and cleats. Participants of Just Kick It! may wear running shoes.

### Try outs for Lanark United (Competitive Youth Teams)

Tryouts will be held for player placement on EODSA/ERSL teams. The tryout process allows the Team Selection Committee to evaluate new and returning players.

Tryout dates: February 25<sup>th</sup> and March 3<sup>rd</sup>

Held at the Beckwith Indoor Soccer Facility

### Team Selection

Players trying out for Lanark United will be advised as to whether they were selected to a team by March 15th. Refunds of the competitive portion of the registration fee will be issued by mid-May for those players not placed on a competitive team, but who will be playing in the recreational league.

Recreational players will be advised of their team placement by early to mid-May. Adjustments to team rosters may be necessary early in the season to balance teams if there are 2 or more CP teams in one division.

### Spring Training

Competitive Teams will enjoy the benefit of at least six weeks of Spring Training (March - May) at the Beckwith Indoor Facility.

### Coaches' Corner

## Registration

On line registration is now open. It's quick, easy and paperless! Be sure to register before March 1<sup>st</sup> to take advantage of the early bird fees.

However, if you plan on attending the competitive try outs you **must be registered by February 23<sup>rd</sup>**. Registration will close on April 30<sup>th</sup>, after this time players are not guaranteed a spot on a team

### Steps to On-Line Registration

1. Go to the Club website at [www.cpsoccer.ca](http://www.cpsoccer.ca)
2. Click the REGISTER tab along the top. Review the information listed, printing out instructions if needed.
3. Click on the green REGISTER button to proceed with player registration.
4. Payment may be made by credit card or cheque, mailed in to CPSC. If you choose credit card payment, your registration will be complete once your payment has been authorized. If you choose cheque payment, your registration will be placed in a hold status until payment is received and processed by the Club.

**NOTE: A registration will not be considered complete until the appropriate fees have been processed and the registration has been accepted by the Club.**
